### Tivoli - Villa d'Este



Departure from Piazzale Aldo Moro at 2.00 p.m. (approx. one-hour route).

Guided tour of Villa d'Este, a 16th-century structure and UNESCO World Heritage Site, a must-see historic landmark. The Villa features landscaped gardens, lavish fountains, statues and grottos that will take your breath away.

After the visit return to Rome (Piazzale Aldo Moro) at approximately 6.30 p.m.

\*The minimum number to be able to organize the excursion is 30 people. The cost is € 55.00 per person; payment by credit card and Paypal by June 26<sup>th</sup>.
